INCOMING STUDENTS

- International Students Ages 16-20 (15-21)
- International Students Responsible For
 - Airfare
 - Medical/Travel Insurance
 - Visa
 - Spending Money/Camp Fees
- Host Families
 - Do not have to be Lions
 - Have a local Host Lions Club
 - Pass background check (over 18)
- Need to have a Local Host Club from their Countries



THREE-WEEK HOSTING PERIOD

- Students arrive the Saturday before July 4th
- Host Families to pick up at airport
- Host Families bring students to Camp

















WHAT TO DO WITH STUDENTS DURING HOSTING?

- MOST IMPORTANT TREAT THEM AS IF THEY ARE YOUR CHILD

CLUB SPONSOR

Sponsoring a Student to go to another Country

- Student does not have to have a family member in Lions.
- Meet the Student and Family, this could be from a contest you hold, a child or grandchild.
- Host a fundraiser to help students with costs of exchange. (NOT Mandatory)
- Include family and student in any fundraising.
- Invite them to a club meeting before and after exchange so they can tell you about their experience.
- While age range is 15-21, most camps require students to be 17. They will have hosting available for 15- & 16-year-olds.
- Invite family to become Lions



HOST CLUB

Sponsoring a host family here in lowa

- Meet the Host family, would you let your child and/or grandchild stay there?
- Invite Student and family to a club meeting and fundraisers during hosting.
 Student will make a great program.
- Ask the family if they need any help entertaining the student
- Emergency contact during hosting when Youth Exchange Chair is not available.
- All family members 18+ will need to pass a background check.

VOLUNTEER AT CAMP

- Camp is one week, we set up on Saturday
- Students come on Sunday Morning and leave the following Saturday
- We have cabins and bunk beds, bring your own bedding.

- Help with food preparation. Clean up, dishes, errands (stays at camp-does not need to be all week)
- Help with camp activities (does not have to be all week)
- Assist students with Flag Ceremonies/Flag set up (all week May Need)
- Assist students with Country Talks (all week)
- Assist Students with Talent Show (all week Have)
- Banker keeps track of Student money, passports, valuables. (all week)
- Chaperone (rides bus all week Have)
